

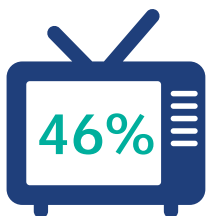

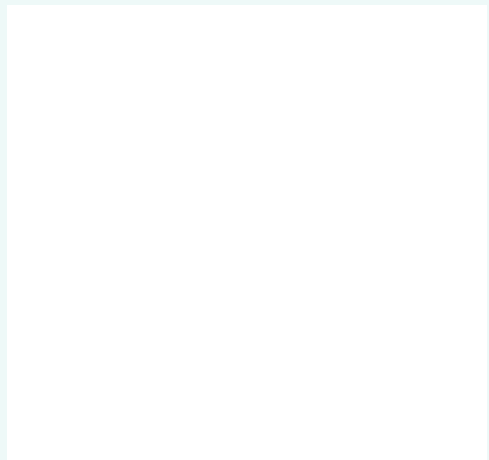
97%

Humanities Skills in the Workplace

81%

of Americans frequently use at least one humanities skill in their jobs.



57%

of American workers often write to describe or explain something on their jobs (and another 20% do so sometimes).

9%

of Americans often use a language other than English on their jobs.



29%

of Americans feel their career advancement was at least partially impaired by a deficiency in one or more humanistic skills.

Americans without a college education are much less likely to respond that they need humanities skills in their jobs.

The highest-income Americans are **substantially more likely** than less-affluent Americans to use humanities skills in their work.
